The phlebotomy clinical is required for completion of the program and if you wish to take the certification exam. To be eligible for the clinical, you must complete the Principles of Phlebotomy course with a grade of 78% or better and receive instructor recommendation.

Phlebotomy Clinical requirements include 100-120 clinical hours with a minimum performance of 100-120 successful sample collections and orientation in a full service laboratory.

After successful completion of this coursework, students will be eligible to sit for the following industry certification: National Phlebotomy Certification Examination to include but not limited to ASCP and American Society of Phlebotomy Technicians (ASPT).
