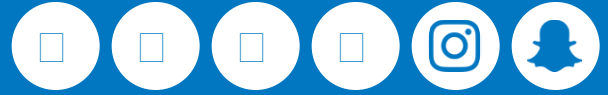

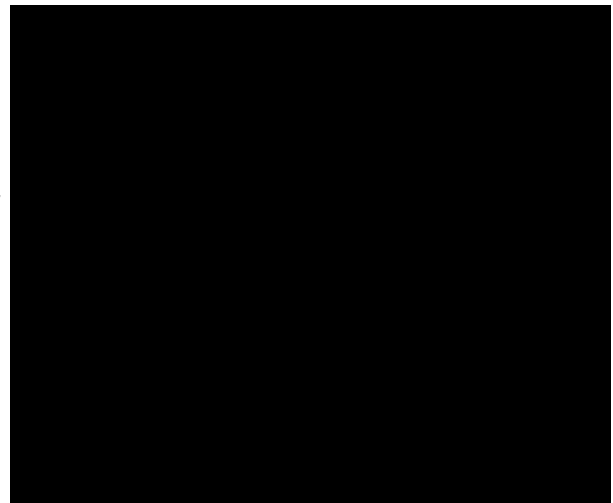


Career Programs & Training
