Things to know:

Foundation Seminars

Recommended for scale technicians with less than three years of experience, our two-hour foundation seminars provide a deeper understanding of the presented material and the opportunity to resolve questions before moving on to the general session and scale training.

Seminars meet before the general session and scale certification training and are adapted to each scale category (small, large, or retail computing).

Foundation seminars do not replace the general session.

Payment Options

Cost: \$100 per module, the foundation seminars will remain at \$85. There is no charge for the mandatory general session. Payment will be accepted on the day of training by check or credit card.




