Online Advisor Development Course

The online Advisor Development course is based on the three Foundations of Academic Advising as outlined by NACADA:

1. **Conceptual**
This component contains articles related to NACADA Core Values and theories of academic advising to help advisors understand the scope of advising and their role in it. This begins the process for developing their own philosophy for advisement.
2. **Informational**
This component includes Barton specific information on policies, procedures and processes for advisement and other college depts. such as financial aid, enrollment services.
3. **Relational**
The Relational component continues the development of the advisor's philosophy with NACADA articles related to working with students in education and special populations.

All of the modules contain scenarios and quizzes pertaining to the information within the module.
