### General Game Notes:

- Barton owns a 23-4 edge over Colby at the Barton Gym, with Colby's last victory coming Feb 15, 2006 when the Lady Trojans won 48-46. Colby was ranked #7 at the time and only led for less than two minutes of the game including the last seven seconds to capture the win. The two teams split the regular season series as the Cougars won 64-61 in Colby. However the Trojans ended Barton's season in the Region VI Championship game 67-62.
- Overall, Barton leads the series 49-7 and has a current twelve game win streak against the Lady Trojans, again dating back to the '06 Region Championship game.
- Both teams need a win - Barton is on a three-game losing streak, with all three losses coming against 3-of-the-4 leaders in the Jayhawk West. Colby is on a six-game losing streak, with five of those coming against the top five teams in the West, with their last win coming Jan 12 against Northwest Tech.
- Barton & Colby have played five conference games against the same opponents. Barton's average score in those five contests was 56.8 to 64.6 while Colby's average score was 44.6 to 69.2.

### About the Lady Cougars:

- The Cougars have had a week from action since last Wednesday's 56-65 loss at #1 Hutchinson....a game the Cougars trailed by only two with three minutes to play.
- In the game versus Hutch, the Barton bench outscored Hutch 16-10...with all of the Cougar's 16 points coming from Taschell Phillips. Erin Copeland was the only other Cougar in double-digits with 13.
- The free throw line has not been kind to the Cougars this season, ranking last in the West at 58.4% and is setting sights of dubious honors.
- Since conference play has begun, sophomore Erin Copeland is averaging 10.1 pts per game in Barton five conference games.
- Freshman Ashton Bruner is the only Lady Cougar to average double-digit scoring (10.1) but has not reached double-digit scoring since putting up 21 in the conference opener at Seward.

### About the Lady Trojans:

- Colby has lost its conference games by an average of 26 points per game and are averaging only 43.1 points per game in conference play.
- In Colby's 81-28 loss to #1 Hutch on Sunday, the Trojans were held to season low point (28) and field-goal percentage (16.3%)
- Colby picked up two victories this season by forfeit coming from previously nationally ranked Western Nebraska due to an ineligible player.
- Colby leads the West in 3-point launches, making a league high 112 out of 390 attempts. Unfortunately for the Trojans, they also rank near last place in 3-point completion percentage at 28.7. Agnese Aramina is second in the West in made 3-pointers at 2.28 per game (41 of 129).
- Aramina's 21 steals is one of three Colby players with 20 or more steals.

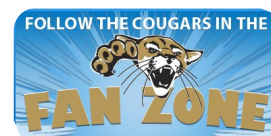

## General Game Notes:

- Barton owns a 25-1 edge over Colby at the Barton Gym, with Colby's only victory at Barton coming February 14, 2004 when the #13 Trojans defeated the #20 ranked Cougars 84-81.
- Overall, Barton leads the series 41-8 and has a current three game win streak against the Trojans. Colby's last win came in the 2010-11 season when Barton squandered a 22 point halftime lead to lose 77-75 in Colby. Barton is 11-1 against the Trojans in the last twelve games.
- Barton & Colby have played five conference games against the same opponents. Barton's average score in those five contests was 71.8 to 65.4 while Colby's average score was 61.6 to 71.6.

## About the Cougars:

- The Cougars have had a week from action since last Wednesday's 79-77 loss at #1 Hutchinson. Struggling all night against the Dragons, Barton had two opportunities late in the game to take the lead.
- Barton has three players averaging double figures and three more averaging close or over eight points per game.
- Sophomore Algie Key was held to a season low 6 points vs Hutchinson, well below his 18 pt average, and only the third time this season to score less than 10 pts in a game.
- Since his conference opening 12 rebounds, freshman Raheem Johnson's rebounding has declined each game (7, 6, 5, 2).
- Sophomore Turon Parker kept the Cougars within striking distance against Hutch scoring 19 of his team high 21 points in the second half. During conference season Parker is shooting 57% from 3-point territory.
- Freshman Kevin Kuteyi has been big for the Cougars coming off the bench, averaging 10.8 in conference play including 16 coming against Hutch. He is also shooting 45.8 behind the arc in those five game.
- In conference play alone, sophomore Andell Cumberbatch has posted a double-double in 3-out-of-5 games, just missing his fourth with a 10 point 9 rebound performance at Garden City.

## About the Trojans:

- The Trojans are led by a couple of former Jayhawk Conference players and brothers. First year head coach Rusty Grafel was a member of Hutchinson's 2004 Jayhawk West championship team playing at HCC from 2002-04. Brother Egan, who is the Trojans assistant coach, played at Cloud County.
- Colby started the season winning six-straight games but are on a six-game conference losing streak.
- Similar to the Lady Trojans, the Trojans are near the top of the Jayhawk West in 3-point categories, leading in made 3-pointers (130) and second in attempts (393) and rank 3rd in percentage at 33.1%.
- Kris Rolle leads the West in all rebound statistics: Offensive Rebounds (5.74), Defensive Rebounds (7.84), and Total Rebounds (13.6). He also average 10.1 points per game.
- Freshman Terry Starks leads the West in steals (2.6) and is second in assists (5.55).
- Defense has been a struggle at times for Colby in 2012-13. The Trojans are allowing a league-worst 69.9 points per game. That number goes up to 70.6 points in league play. Colby is allowing 43.4 percent shooting (8th in the West) and 33.7 percent from long range (also 8th).
