### General Game Notes:

- In Control....Barton women have dominated the series with Pratt as the Lady Cougars have won twelve straight. Barton's last lost to Pratt was on Jan 6, 2005 at the Barton Gym.
- In the last ten meetings at the Barton Gym, Barton has won nine of the ten and a 24.1 point average margin of victory.
- In the preseason KJCCC Coaches Poll, Barton was picked to finish 6th while Pratt was picked to finish 7th. Currently Barton is in 5th place with Pratt sitting in 8th.
- Four of Pratt's conference losses have come to the top four teams in the conference standings.
- Barton's three conference losses have come to three of the top four teams in the conference standings.

### About the Lady Cougars:

- With Barton's Wednesday night road victory against Colby, the Lady Cougars improved to 3-3 in conference play. All three of those victories coming on the other team's home court.
- The Lady Cougars are 8-3 at home this season.
- In Barton's Wednesday night road victory over Colby, Barton overcame a sluggish start to close out the first half with a 33-11 run, including a 23-2 run in the middle ten minutes of the half. After leading by as much as 17, Barton found itself trailing twice late in the game but defensive pressure and timely free throws preserved the Lady Cougar win...the Lady Cougars seventh straight win in Colby.
- Dionne Harris leads Barton averaging 13.8 points a game while grabbing 7.6 rebounds per contest. Blair Bloomfield and Shea Shoemaker each average just under 9 points and 5 rebounds.
- Harris won week five honors being named the KJCCC and NJCAA player of the week.

### About the Beavers:

- Coach Thompson is in her fourth season at the helm. Last season, she led the Lady Beavers to their most wins (13) in a season since Pratt's 2004-05 season...which was also the last time Pratt beat Barton.
- Pratt finished last season with a 2-12 record in the conference. They are currently 1-5 this season.
- Three players are averaging double figure scoring for the Lady Beavers...and they are all sophomores. Ann Pauley leads Pratt at 13.3 points followed by Cari Guyton with 12.2 points and Whitney Bates at 11.4 points a game.
- Bates leads the Jayhawk Conference in assists with 5.6 dishes a contest while Guyton is 2nd in rebounds at 9.3 rebounds per contest.
- Pratt leads the conference in free throw percentage at 69.8 percent a game.

### General Game Notes:

- Barton has turned the tides from its 0-2 conference start and has won 4 straight conference games.
- Pratt lost its first four conference games before getting a road victory against Butler and then losing Wednesday to Hutch at home by 22pts, giving them a 1-5 Jayhawk West Conference Record.
- In the last ten years Barton is 15-5 against Pratt with Pratt's last win being a 3 point edge in 2010 on the Cougar's court.
- Barton Community College Athletic Director Trevor Rolfs, was the Head Coach of the Pratt Men's team the previous 7 years.
- Barton has moved up four spots to #10 in the latest NJCAA Division I national poll. There are seven KJCCC schools either ranked in the Top 20 or receiving votes. Four of the seven coming from the West Division...with two of those four being ranked in Top 10. (Seward #9, Barton #10)
- The last time that Pratt swept a season series was during the 1977-1978 season. Barton last swept Pratt in the 2011 season.

### About the Cougars:

- The Cougars had a big road win at Colby on Wednesday night where they led by as many as 34 points and cruised for a 23 point victory...their fifth in six trips to Colby.
- The Cougars are still leading the conference in several statistical categories: Scoring, Margin of Victory, Offensive Rebs, Defensive Rebs, Rebound Margin, Assists, Blocks, and Assist-to-Turnover Ratio.
- Barton has four players averaging double figures. Freshman Algie Key leads with 18.7 points a game and is second in the West at 5.9 assists per game. Sophomores Dwayne Brunson follows with 16.9 per game, Carl Wallace scores 12.0, and Darius Hill checks in at 10.1 points a game.
- Ten Cougars average more than 4 points per game.
- Brunson leads the West in shot blocks and rebounding.

### About the Beavers:

- Pratt's only conference win came against Butler on the road where they edged out a six point win.
- Pratt's sophomore Bryton Hobbs leads the West in assists at 6.2 a game while freshman Aaron Abram leads in 3pt field goal percentage. Hobbs also leads his team in scoring at 18.3 points a game which is good for 7th in the West Division.
- The Beavers are ranked 3rd in the Jayhawk West Conference in 3pt offensive and defensive percentage.
- The last time the Beavers reached the Region VI Finals was in Barton Athletic Director Trevor Rolfs' first year as coach for Pratt.

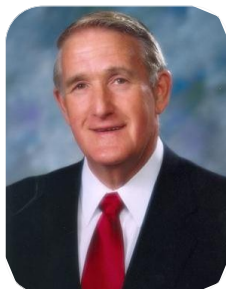
