In six seasons at Barton, Coach Twelvetrees teams are 112-17-4 at .84 win %. In 2010 Barton had the best year in school history coming 3rd at Nationals. He has guided the men's soccer program to Jayhawk Conference titles in 2007, 2008 & 2010 with **Region VI Titles** in 2007, 2008, 2009 & 2010. In 2011 Barton saw its first player signed by an MLS club when Kevin Ellis inked a homegrown player contract with Sporting KC. With Coach Twelvetrees at the helm of the men's soccer program, Barton have been ranked as high as **#1 in the Nation in 2011** and finished in the Top 10 in the NSCAA & NJCAA ranking in each of the last 5 years. Another remarkable streak is the fact that Twelvetrees has coached at least one All American every year with a total of eight in five years. Coach Twelvetrees' biggest accomplishment is placing **30 players between 2006-2010 onto NCAA D1, D2 and NAIA four year universities**. He also currently serves as the Head ODP Coach of 95 boys in Kansas and is on the coach education staff for Kansas Youth Soccer Association.
