Overview

The Strategic Planning framework is the foundation for a strategic management approach through which Barton's leadership team takes responsibility for leading the

institution through change, defining the knowledge critical to planning strategically for the college's future, deciding how to interpret that knowledge and how to apply it to plans and decisions that lead to continuous improvement of Barton's programs, services and operations. In this model planners at all levels of the college are able to determine performance "gaps" at the institutional and divisional/department levels and implement initiatives to close those gaps. Senior administrators, with input from internal stakeholders, can allocate resources to support the Strategic Plan and ongoing operations that are essential to closing those performance gaps.

The basic operating principles of the Strategic Planning Framework are:

- 1. Barton exists to create success for its students and the communities it serves.
- 2. To create stakeholder success, Barton must develop appropriate capacity and function at ever--- higher levels of effectiveness. The Strategic Plan functions as a map for student success, relying on 4 Core Priorities (Values) and 9 Goals (Can change Yearly). Barton
