

"However it is done, communication is the key to human interaction", said Amanda Schaumburg, speech pathologist and board member of Texas' Panhandle Regional Speech and Hearing Association. She has encountered a couple of bumps along the way to becoming the first person in her immediate family to attend college. In high school, she moved from Watertown, South Dakota to Russell, Kansas in the middle of her senior year. Later, she tried to attend Lincoln Trail Community College, but it didn't work out because her husband's job required them to travel frequently and online education was not an option at the time. It was later on when inspired by her cousin, Amber, that Laura took the next step and began attending Barton Community College.

Amber, who was raising a family and working toward her nursing degree at Barton Community College, motivated Laura to be strong and continue with her education. It was at this time Laura found her way to the Barton Community College TRiO - Central Kansas Educational Opportunity Center's (CKEOC) office for assistance in completing Financial Aid and admissions applications. 
CKEOC Outstanding Participant: Laura Sanchez (cont.)




