- * Subject to placement or pre-requisite requirements
- An active Kansas Certified Nurse Aide certification is a requirement for Certified Medication Aide training.
- Students must complete required compliance tracking, including background check and immunization records
- Students enrolled in an online class must attend lab and clinical sessions.
- Successfully complete one of the following reading requirements within the last five years. Our program will accept the minimum reading scores of: ACT=14 or greater, Accuplacer Next-Gen=237 or greater, TABE=518 or greater, CASAS=224 or greater, TEAS=58.7% or greater, eligible for Integrated Reading and Writing, or completed College level English Composition 1 with a "C" or greater.
- Must be 18 years of age by the time of state testing.
