RiPS is an 8-week summer research program offered by the Kansas Louis Stokes Alliance for Minority Participation. Students will complete an independent research project after being paired with a Kansas State University faculty mentor. The overall goal of the program is to provide summer academic and professional preparation to underrepresented students interested in STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Math) fields.



## WHO CAN APPLY

- Current community college students who have completed at least one year at their community college

- Current K-State students who have no previous experience working in a research lab.

Eligible students should have completed College Algebra and one college-level science course (ex. Biology, Chemistry

## RIPS PROGRAM PERKS

- Mentored research experience

- Scholarship \$3,000

- Housing and meals provided by the program

- Participation in organized social events with other summer research students
