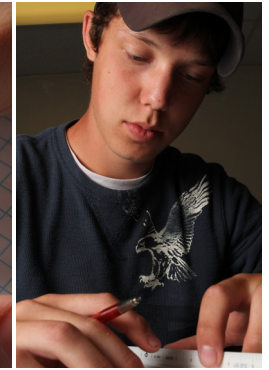

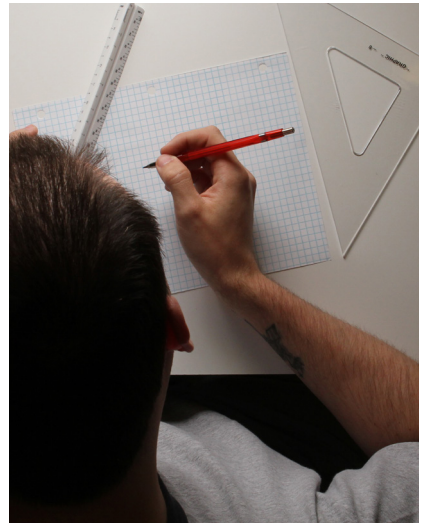
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Why Barton?

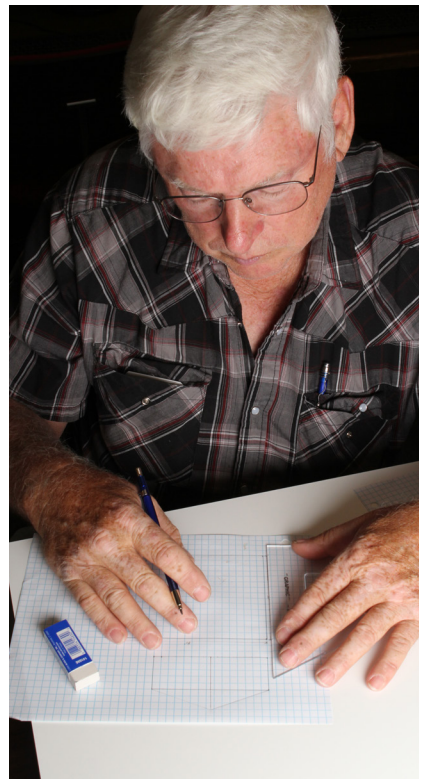

Occupational Outlook

- National median wages (2010) were \$23.46 hourly which leads to an annual amount of \$48,810
- Educational requirements breakdown as follows:
 - o Associate's Degree - 40%
 - o Some College, No Degree - 31%
 - o Bachelor's Degree - 23%
- According to the 2006-2016 Kansas Occupational Outlook information from the Kansas Department of Labor growth potential in this field indicates a percentage increase of 11.1%



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
