Certified Nurse Aide

The certified nurse aide course (CNA) is a 90 contact hour course that prepares students for the state certification exam. The CNA course is regulated by the Kansas Department of Health and Environment. CNAs provide direct care to patients of hospitals and residents of assisted living centers and long term care facilities. Students must be 16 years old to enroll. Maximum number of students in a CNA class is 6.

Certified Nurse/Medication Aide Checklist

1. Apply to Barton
2. Complete Adult Healthcare Registration Form
3. Complete Adult Healthcare Student Information Form
4. Complete Immunization Records Form
5. Complete Legal Relationship Form
6. Passing reading assessment score; if you have not taken a reading assessment test, you can take one at Barton. To set up a reading assessment test time, contact Lisa Peterson at (620) 792-9344. It is a free test. If you have taken one previously at another site, please provide us with a copy. If you have taken a minimum of English Composition 1 with a passing grade of "C" or better, you do NOT need to take the reading assessment. Barton will accept any of the following scores:
 - ACT - 14 (Reading section, not overall scorings)
 - Accuplacer - 54
 - Asset - 35
 - Compass - 58
 - CASAS - 236
7. Payment arrangements MUST be made before you are secured a spot in class.
8. Check out the textbooks list to purchase required books.

Certified Medication Aide

The Certified Medication Aide is a 75 contact hour course that prepares students for the state certification exam. CMAs administer medications to residents in assisted living centers, hospitals, and long term care facilities. A Certified Nurse Aide certification is a requirement for CMA training. Students must be 18 years old to enroll. Maximum number of students in a CMA class is 6.

Certified Medication Aide Update

Certified Medication Aide Update Classes provide required continuing education for Certified Medication Aides. Kansas Department and Aging Disability Services (KDADS) regulations require that you update your certification every two years. The CMA Certificate cannot be lapsed by one year or more. Paper work is sent to KDADS after the course ends. It takes KDADS a minimum of 2 weeks to process the update.
