Instructor Coordinator (IC) Course

Information concerning NREMT EMT written assessment & practical skills

1. Must be completed within the past 12 months
 - a. Level of certification does not matter. You must take the NREMT EMT written assessment and practical exam per K.A.R. 109-9-4
2. Cost is at your own expense
3. ***Both exams must be successfully completed prior to the June 25th deadline***
4. Practical exam
 - a. All psychomotor applications are turned into the KSBEMS at least 15 days in advance by the exam site. Waiting may result in exclusion from participating in a psychomotor exam and will nullify your IC application.
 - b. Barton is hosting an EMT test site in Great Bend on Thursday, May 13th.
 - i. Must submit Barton EMT Psychomotor application by April 22nd
 1. Contact Karyl for Psychomotor Application
 - ii. Limited space available
 - iii. \$100.00 fee
 - c. Other exam dates are available through the KSBEMS
 - i. www.ksbems.org
5. The written assessment registration must be completed through the Kansas Board of EMS
 - a. Email **both** Carman Allen and Curt Shreckengaust

 - c. Curt.shreckengaust@ks.gov
6. Once you have successfully completed your NREMT EMT testing, you will be placed on a list of eligible candidates with the Kansas Board of EMS.
7. You need to notify Barton when you have completed both your exams so we can contact BEMS to confirm your eligibility as an IC candidate.
