

# BARTON PN NURSING PROGRAM SELECTION CRITERIA

Applicants are assigned points in the following areas:

1. Admission Test (TEAS) composite score (maximum points-10) \_\_\_\_\_  
(Example: Test score 95% = 9.5 points)
  
2. Overall College GPA (Maximum – 4 pts) \_\_\_\_\_  
(Any courses to be considered need to be on your Barton Transcript- Must have a minimum overall college GPA of 2.5)
  
3. Complete pre-requisite general education courses with a GPA of 3.0 or better (Maximum points- 5; 1pt/course) \_\_\_\_\_  
(Any courses to be considered need to be on your Barton Transcript)

    - TEAS Math score of 50 or higher
    - ACT Math score of 21 or higher
    - ASSET Math score of 39 or higher
    - Accuplacer College level math score of 1-44+
- If a student does not meet the minimum Math requirement, they must first complete Math modules 1-8 in College Preparatory Math.
