

## **Barton RN Nursing Program Selection Criteria**

Applicants are assigned points in the following areas:

1. Overall College GPA (maximum 4 points) \_\_\_\_\_  
(Any courses to be considered need to be on your Barton transcript)
  
2. Completed general education courses with a grade of "C" or better (Maximum 4 points) \_\_\_\_\_  
(Any courses to be considered need to be on your Barton transcript and must have a GPA of 3.0 or higher on the 4 required general education courses)  
\_\_\_ Microbiology                      \_\_\_ English Comp I  
\_\_\_ Public Speaking                      \_\_\_ Sociology
  
3. Nursing courses GPA (maximum 4 points) \_\_\_\_\_  
(If in the 2<sup>nd</sup> semester of a PN program, must have a passing grade in all nursing courses to be considered as an RN applicant)  
(Any courses to be considered must be on your Barton transcript)
  
4. Three (3) letters of endorsement (1 point /letter) \_\_\_\_\_  
(Letters of endorsement must be from a Preceptor, Employer or Instructor and mailed directly to the Executive Director of Nursing Education)
