

Barton Financial Aid Facts:

- The average financial aid package offered to Barton students for 19-20 was \$5,288.00, which was a combination of federal, state, institutional, and other aid.
- The largest financial aid award paid to a Barton student in 19-20 was \$23,393.00.
- 49% of Barton federal aid applicants processed for 19-20 were eligible for a Federal Pell Grant. 64% of those Federal Pell-eligible were eligible for the maximum Federal Pell Grant of \$6,195.
