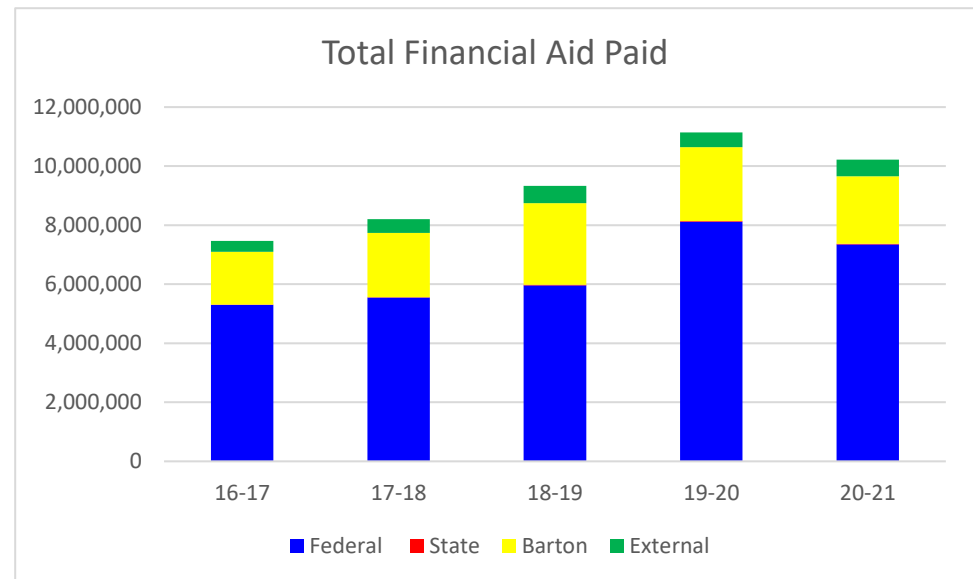

Barton Financial Aid Facts:

- The average financial aid package offered to Barton students for 20-21 was \$4,894.00, which was a combination of federal, state, institutional, and other aid.
- The largest financial aid award paid to a Barton student in 20-21 was \$15,127.00.
- 68% of Barton federal aid applicants processed for 20-21 were eligible for a Federal Pell Grant. 63% of those Federal Pell-eligible were eligible for the maximum Federal Pell Grant of \$6,345.
