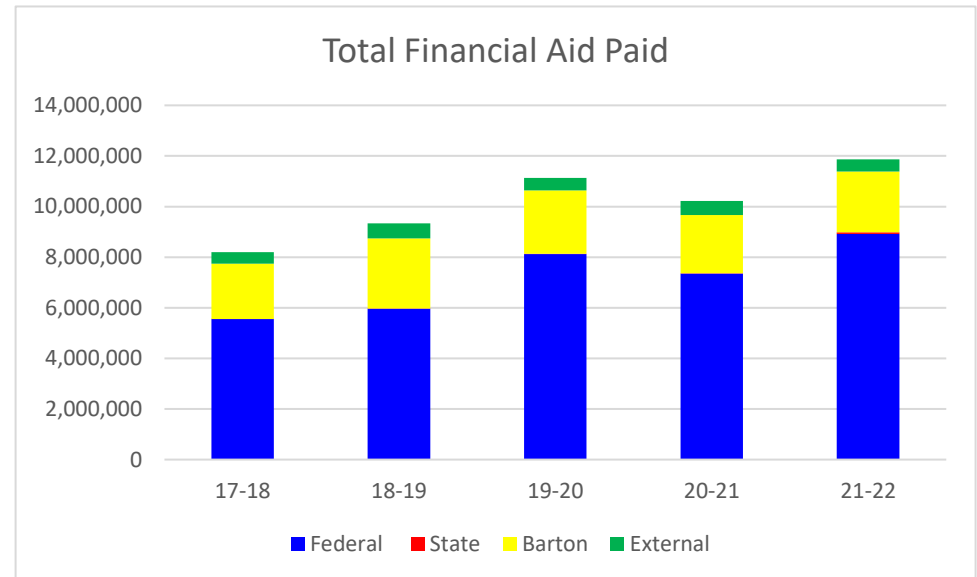

## Barton Financial Aid Facts:

- The average financial aid package offered to Barton students for 21-22 was \$8,340.00, which was a combination of federal, state, institutional, and other aid.
- The largest financial aid award paid to a Barton student in 21-22 was \$23,808.00.
- 70% of Barton federal aid applicants processed for 21-22 were eligible for a Federal Pell Grant. 68% of those Federal Pell-eligible were eligible for the maximum Federal Pell Grant of \$6,495.
