

### Barton Financial Aid Facts:

- Barton County residents received \$1,749,149 in financial aid in 2022-23. Ft. Riley students received \$1,441,768.
- On average, 86% of first-time/full-time students attending Barton receive some type of financial aid according to data submitted to the National Center for Education Statistics for 2021-22.
- 2,164 students received financial aid in 22-23. The average award was \$4,731. The largest total paid to one was in 22-23 was \$20,610.
- Maximum Federal Pell Grant for 2022-23 was \$6,895.
