# College Program Frequently Asked Questions:

- **What does hybrid mean?**
  - Hybrid means that a portion of the courses are in class and a portion of the courses are online.
- **How much do the courses cost?**
  - These courses are \$120 per credit hour.
- **When is payment due for the courses?**
  - Payment is due for these courses by the end of the semester. For example, if you are taking classes in the Fall semester, the payment will not be due until December. The full amount for courses must be paid before you can take any courses in the Spring semester. Until the balance is paid in full, a hold will be placed on your final grades and transcripts.
- **Where do I get my books?**
  - Books will be provided to the students on the first night of class. The books must be returned to the instructor at the end of the cycle or if the class is dropped. If the book is not returned, then a charge will be placed on your account and you will no longer be able to take classes until you return the book or pay for it.
- **How often do the classes run?**
  - Classes are held for 8 weeks at a time and there are five cycles a year. There are two 8-week cycles in the Spring and Fall semesters and there is one 8-week cycle in the Summer semester.
- **What days of the week are classes held?**
  - The classes are held 1-2 nights a week between Monday and Friday for 3 hours. The day for each class does vary each cycle, you will need to look at a schedule to determine the day of your class. Any holidays for the cycle are also posted on the schedule\*
- **If I am a civilian, can I take these courses even though they are held on Fort Riley?**
  - Anyone can take the night courses, you do not need to be affiliated with the military in order to attend.
- **When will the next schedule be out?**
  - The college program class schedules are usually released 1 week after the previous cycle has started.
- **If I am active duty, will Tuition Assistance (TA) pay for the full cost of the course?**
  - Active duty soldiers utilizing TA will owe the fees for these classes. The cost of the fees is \$38 per credit hour. TA will pay for the tuition of the class, which is \$120 per credit hour. The soldier will not have to purchase a book for the class because they are provided. If you are utilizing TA, then it must be requested the day before the class is first scheduled to meet.
