All Barton LSEC classes have a required minimum of 10 students. Classes that do not meet the student minimum are subject to cancelation.

Students are only eligible to enroll in 3 classes during an LSEC Cycle

Students MUST attend class via zoom on April 14th, however, GoArmyEd enrollment has been extended until April 15, 2020 by Close of Business.

LSEC Frequently Asked Questions

• What does LSEC mean?

o LSEC stands for Leadership Skills Enhancement Courses.

• Are these classes worth college credit?

Yes. The classes offered are general education courses.

• Are they really free?

o LSEC courses are not free. They are scholarship funded courses, so they are no cost to you.

Who qualifies to take these courses?

- Active Duty Eligible to take classes, must have commander approval for E-6 and below.
 - Immediate Family Member Eligible to take classes with Military ID. Must show ID when enrolling*
- o **Retired Military** Eligible to take classes, must show Military ID.
 - Immediate Family Member Eligible to take classes with Military ID. Must show ID when enrolling*
- Guard/Reservist Eligible to take classes, must show Military ID
 - Immediate Family Member Eligible to take classes with Military ID. Must show ID when enrolling*
- DOD Eligible to take classes, must show DOD ID.
 - Spouse Eligible to take classes. Sponsor must show proof of ID every 6 months when enrolling.
 - **Child** Eligible to take classes if under the age of 26. Prior to class starting, the sponsor (DOD card holder) of that child must show ID. This must be done every 6 months.
- Veteran Eligible to take classes. Must provide DD-214 showing honorable discharge or Veteran ID when enrolling for classes.

• How do I enroll in an LSEC class?

There is a two-part enrollment that must be completed prior to class starting. You must enroll in GoArmyEd for an on duty course with the Education Center. If this step is not completed by the posted deadline on the schedule, you will not be able to attend the class. You must also enroll with Barton Community College for the same class.

Where do I get my book?

You will receive your book on the first day of class from the instructor. Books must be returned to the
instructors on the last day of the course or if the course is dropped. If the book is not returned, then a
charge will be placed on your account and you will no longer be able to take classes until you return the
book or pay for it.

• How often do classes run?

Classes are held for 6 weeks at a time and there are 7 cycles a year. During the Fall and Spring semesters
there are three 6-week cycles offered. During the Summer semester, there is one 6-week LSEC cycle
offered.

When will the next schedule be out?

o The LSEC class schedules are usually released 1 week after the start date of the previous cycle.

• What days of the week are the classes held?

 LSEC courses are held Monday through Friday at the designated time on the schedule. Any holidays for the cycle are also posted on the schedule**

• Can I take Bartonline or College Program classes at the same time?

Yes. You can work with your advisor to create a schedule that works best for you.

^{*}If a child of one of the qualifying categories does not have an ID and is under the age of 26 prior to class starting, the sponsor of that child must show ID for the child every 6 months. Any child 26 and older is no longer eligible to take the LSEC classes.
