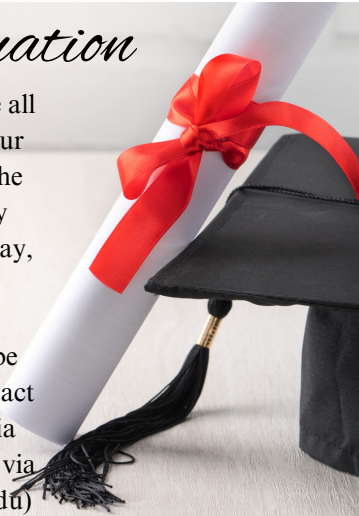


Graduation

What does Earth Day mean to you?

- Earth Day is a day to celebrate the Earth's environment and help raise awareness of threats to our planet's health. On April 22 of each year, people around the world plant trees, commute to work by bicycle and pick up trash in their neighborhoods to observe Earth Day, an event to shine a spotlight on environmental concerns and to celebrate the Earth's environment and help raise awareness to threats to our planet's health.
- The first Earth Day was organized by Gaylord Nelson, a former U.S senator from Wisconsin, in 1970 as a way to bring environmental protection onto the national political agenda.
- Today, the Earth Day Network and EPA organize events and volunteer opportunities in every region of the U.S. to give citizens a way to organize to directly affect the environment around them.
