
CLASS

We have received some calls and there seems to be some confusion about the benefit you receive regarding admission to Cougar basketball games. It does not include reserve seats or admission to the Cougars Den for pre-game meals. As for seating inside the gymnasium, even though there is an area designated for the SCC – you are not required to seat there – you may sit in any of the general admission (bleacher sections) seating in the gym.

Silver Cougar Club Special Events

We have received a few questions recently regarding the discontinuance of our day trips. The following article was published in our March/April 2017 issue and explains how and why we came to that decision.

As many of you know, on August 1, 2016 I assumed the position of Executive Director of Institutional Advancement. Shortly thereafter the duties of the office were re-evaluated and as a result the Administration decided not to fill my previous position. As a result, the duties of the Coordinator of Fund Raising and Special Events were reassigned and divided among the three of us. As of this date, that decision has not changed so the Coordinator of the Silver Cougar remains vacant.

There was one area that was affected more than the others – the planning and execution of out-of-town trips for the Silver Cougar Club. As you can imagine the reorganization of three of us doing the work of four has put restraints on our time and energy. In addition, over the last year or so the interest in these trips has dropped off considerably – our last couple of trips were not full and we even had to cancel outings for a lack of interest. The research, planning, and ultimately time out of the office for our out-of-town trips was determined to be one area we would need to cut back on in order to give full attention to other fund raising responsibilities of our office. I know you all really loved the new bus, but the cost to operate that bus is over twice the expense of the older buses, which truly are no longer conducive to comfortable travel.

The attention and administration of our endowment, enhancement, and scholarship programs must take priority.

We will still, from time to time, plan special events either on campus or in town and of course we will continue to host our annual picnic. All other benefits of your Silver Cougar Club membership will remain the same. This is not a decision we took lightly, but one that we are certain you will understand.


