- Redistribute


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Barton Certification **Notations**

- No-Cost No outof-pocket expense required of the student for curriculum support materials.
- Low-Cost Up to \$50 curriculum support materials cost for out-ofpocket expenses. (Based on student survey-Spring 2018)
- Open Textbook -Course uses an open textbook, but course materials are above the Low-Cost threshold.
