

Head Coach Craig Fletchall



Craig "Fletch" Fletchall is in his 9th season leading the Cougars. On November 8, 2013, Fletch picked up win #189 earning the top spot for wins in Barton men's basketball history surpassing Dan McGovern's 188 mark set during the 1986-1994 seasons.

Entering the 2013-14 campaign, Fletch's record at Barton was 185-72 - an average of almost 23 wins a season and a .720 winning percentage. Throughout Fletch's collegiate career coaching, his record entering the season is 286-130, good for a .689 win percentage.

Last season Fletch guided the Cougars to a 28-6 season, 12-4 in the rugged Jayhawk West division, ending the season one victory away from the NJCAA Division I Tournament and finishing at #24 in the nation. The Cougars captured a road quarterfinal victory then knocked off the Jayhawk West regular season champion before falling in the Region VI Championship game to the nation's number nine ranked team.

Prior to last season, Fletch guided the Cougars to a 26-7 season and ten consecutive weeks in the NJCAA Division I

Top 20. After knocking off the #5 ranked team in the country in the Region VI quarterfinals, the Cougars season came to an end in the semifinals.

Under Fletch the Cougars have spent a lot of time ranked in the NJCAA Top 25 with the highest ranking coming in the 2011-12 season as Barton climbed all the way to 7th in the polls. This matched the feat of his 2009 team that captured the Jayhawk West title but lost in the Region VI semifinals.


Prior to coming to Barton, Fletch was the head coach at Neosho County Community College, where he spent 5 seasons with the Panthers going 101-58. In his final season at Neosho, Fletch guided Neosho to the Region VI finals for the 1st time in school history. The Tigers were ranked as high as 12th that year - the highest in Neosho history.

Fletch has spent most of his career in the Jayhawk Conference and its surrounding communities, growing up in Hutchinson and attending college at Wichita State University and Fort Hays State University. He spent 11 seasons in the high school ranks, winning a state title at Hutch Trinity in 1987. Trinity was where Fletch started his coaching career, going 40-9 in his 2 seasons with the state title in 1987. After winning the state title, Fletch moved on to Wichita Kapaun Mount Carmel where he guided the Crusaders for three seasons before taking the job at Shawnee Mission East. In his 6 years at East, his clubs went 86-47 and posted the school record for number of wins at 19 in his final season in 1996. His teams won back-to-back Sub State titles (the only time in school history). He earned league Coach of the Year honors at Trinity (1987) and East (1993). Fletch was 146-99 in his 11 seasons at the high school level.



Fletch began his service in the Jayhawk Conference as an assistant at Cowley County Community College for three seasons. The Tigers set the school record for wins in 2 of those 3 seasons. In 1998 – Fletch's initial season at Cowley – the Tigers won 25 games only to better that mark in 2000 at 26. From there he moved on to Neosho where he took the Panthers to within a game of the NJCAA National Tournament.

Fletch and his wife Patty have three children Morgan, Mara, and Melyne.

Assistant Coach Matt Hundley


Matt Hundley begins his fourth season as an assistant for Barton. During his previous three seasons, Hundley has helped guide the Cougars to a 73-25 record including two trips to the Region VI Final Four, most recently falling in the Region VI Championship game.

Prior to Barton, Hundley spent 4 seasons at Topeka West High School, with the best of the seasons coming in his final year falling in the Class 5A State Championship game. For his team's efforts, Hundley was tabbed City Co-Coach of the Year by the Topeka Capital-Journal.

Prior to his 4 years in Topeka, Hundley was the coach at Lyndon High School for two seasons and started his coaching career fresh out of college as a student assistant and graduate assistant for Bob Chipman at Washburn University for two seasons. He played collegiately at Washburn helping the Topeka school to a runner-up finish at the 2001 NCAA Division II National Championships. The Ichabods won the MIAA that year as well.

Hundley was part of a state champion in basketball at Bern High School in 1997 as well as a member of the 1998 state champion track team at Bern.

Hundley is married to Amber Cuevas Hundley, who teaches Social Studies at Great Bend Middle School.

Head Coach Carter Kruger



From AAU basketball to crossing lines to AAU baseball where Clark helped develop nine of his eleven players into college scholarships as well as one Major League draftee. Some games in sports a team performs in an unbeatable manner while the other team's efforts seem futile in comparison. The Region VI Championship was one of those games as the No. 24 Barton men's basketball team ran across a hot No. 9 Hutchinson Community College team falling 74-57 at Park City's Hartman Arena on March 9, 2013.

The Cougars finished the regular season third in the Jayhawk Conference at 12-4 in the conference and 25-5 overall. The road to the championship game began with an easy 93-61 home first round game over Allen Community College then the Cougars erased a 14-point second half deficit to knock off the Jayhawk East second-seeded Cowley College Tigers 75-68 on the Tigers' home floor. Barton advanced to Wichita's Hartman Arena later in the week and eliminated the Jayhawk West champions Seward County Community College 70-64.

The Cougars got behind early in the championship game against Hutchinson the next evening and never recovered to conclude the '12-13 season at 28-6. The 31-3 Blue Dragons advanced to represent Region VI for the first time since 1997 in the 2013 NJCAA Division I Tournament.
