Employee 1 Questions/Comments:

Question concerning the following paragraph:

- Internship, practicum, [field experience](#) and ~~on-the-job training~~ [clinical](#) courses must meet ~~the for a~~ minimum [required by the respective professional accrediting or regulatory agency](#) of 45 hours (60 minute hour) per credit hour.

Does this mean that an internship that does not have an accrediting or regulatory agency overseeing will default to the time-based standard for credit hours? If this is the case, would that be the standard for a laboratory course?

Case in point: NATG 1165 Natural Gas Tech Internship does not have professional accrediting or regulatory agency. This is a 1-4 credit hour internship, credits awarded based on clock time "on-the-job" at the rate of 45 clock hours per credit.
