

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Project Description

Per the recommendation of our Advisory Committee, the Emergency Management/Homeland Security program is requesting the addition of two certificate options (in addition to the CERT2 that is already approved) and one revision to the existing CERT2 for that program. The EMHS program is currently dealing with low numbers of “exited and employed” students and the advisory committee believes that this would remedy that problem by providing multiple exit points for our students. This will also increase completers by having multiple credentials available for the students to complete on their way to completing the CERT2 and AAS program. Each of these certificate options builds into the next and leads to the completion of the CERT2 and AAS.

Proposed Changes

We’d like to add the following two CERT1 options for the EMHS students (see attachment):

Emergency Planning & Mitigation Certificate – 18 hours

Emergency Operations Specialist Certificate – 18 hours

Cert B – 39 hours

AAS – 64 hours
