


Credit Hours

The total number of credits taken at each venue during the year.

Enrollments

The total number of student for-credit enrollments at each venue during the year.

FTE - Full time equivalency

Unduplicated Headcount

The unduplicated count of for-credit students at each venue during the year. The sum of the various venue columns will not equal the Total column because students may be taking classes in more than one venue.

- Freshman A student with less than 30 credit hours total
- Sophomore A student with between 30 and 64 credit hours total

- High School A high school student enrolled in college level undergraduate classes.
- Transfer A student entering the institution for the first time but known to have previously attended a post-secondary institution at the same level (e.g., undergraduate). The student may transfer with or without credit.
