

The Swine Technician position is responsible for the daily care of swine. The position involves working in a research location. Swine Technicians work in an agricultural environment with continuous hands-on interaction with swine and regular structured routines.

Daily routines include:

Adhering to all Choice Genetics Biosecurity processes and protocols

Ensuring the comfort, safety and health of all animals

Ensuring that animals have clean, fresh feed and water at all times.

Maintaining proper environmental conditions and maintenance of ventilation components.

General facility cleaning including power washing

Administer routine vaccinations and treatment of ill and/or injured animals according to CG Standard Operating Procedures.

Routine repair of facility components

Daily data entry

Proper animal handling, movement and transportation processes

Candidates must be capable of walking, stooping, bending, performing repetitive motions and lifting a minimum of 50 pounds with reasonable accommodation.
