

## Syllabus Addendum

**Know your Rights** : Title IX prohibits sex discrimination in educational programs and activities. “No person in the United States shall, on the basis of sex, be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be subjected to discrimination under any education program or activity receiving Federal financial assistance.”

**What Behaviors are Prohibited by Title IX?** In the broadest of terms: discrimination on the basis of sex, sexual harassment, and sexual assault. Specific examples include, but are not limited to: unwelcome touching, sexual innuendo or comments, requests for sexual favors, sexual ridicule, stalking, rape, engaging in sexual activity without consent, displaying or sending sexually suggestive electronic content, or dating violence.

**Barton’s Specific Anti-Discrimination Notice:** To provide equal employment, advancement and learning opportunities to all individuals, employment and student admission decisions at Barton will be based on merit, qualifications, and abilities.
