(300 upstairs, 100 lower level)

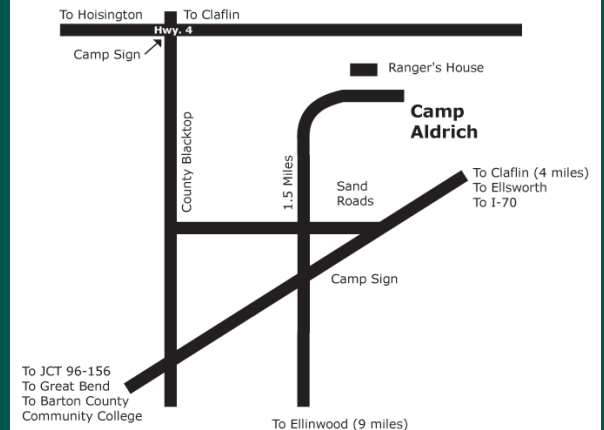
