# OER 3-Year Plan Highlights

- To date – certified 66 OER courses
- Completed the 3-Year Plan a semester early
- Completed our course goals for Fall 2022 – early Feb. 2022
- For the 2021 3-Year Plan Dean’s Report – a calculated savings of \$209,750
  - Current Calculation: (based on OER recommended practices – SPARC, OpenStax, KBOR OER Steering Committee)
    - No-Cost = \$100 savings
    - Low-Cost = \$50 savings
  - Working with Todd to clarify how this calculation will be maintained.

# Future of OER Initiative

- Continuing with Phase II
  - Supporting faculty to continue OER course transition
  - Working toward completing a Low-Cost degree
- Instructional Benefits of Open Education
  - Coordinating with Matt and his team as we have more conversations around open pedagogy, experiential learning, and other teaching methods instructors have at their disposal.
