Camera Project Upgrade

February 2024

261 cameras will be installed which includes 88 customer owned cameras (not previously on contract). Campus Safety will have 331 views. Less cameras – more views.

This also includes new cameras installed at new locations:

Ag Building will have 8 cameras.

2 new cameras will be placed on two poles. 1st pole is located behind the NE driveway college sign and the 2nd pole is located on the NE corner of Unit 30 of the Sunflower Dorm.

1 new camera Fine Arts Circle

1 new camera Shipping/Receiving

1 new camera to cover Union, Fine Arts and Housing foot traffic

Also, 4 new camera servers replaced and upgraded with new software.
