 - Manual campus-wide and individual buildings.



Camera System

- Approximately 300 CCTV cameras
 - Cover
 - All common areas and parking lots in housing
 - All common exterior door on campus
 - Most common areas and hallways on campus
 - Most parking areas on campus
 - Motion or manually activated
 - Store for 3-9 months depending on activity and storage
 - Nextech

Body Cameras

- Taser-Axon
 - Every officer wears
 - Started manually on duty calls (anything more than casual greeting)
 - 30 second pre-start loop
 - Evidence.com online storage
- Reviewing Nextech-Axis
 - Similar system
 - Ties in with current CCTV review program
 - Stored in house
- Importance-vital to our operations, sheriff's department doesn't have

Annual Security and Fire Safety Report

- “Clery Report”
- Reported on Oct. 1 for each previous calendar year to the Department of Education by federal law.
- Covers Title IX offenses (discrimination and sexual) and certain crimes
- Posted on website and distributed to the public according to law
- Gather statistics from our records and law enforcement covering all 5 of our campuses (as defined by Clery requirements)
