ABOUT SSS

- TRIO Student Support Services has been at Barton since 1991
- In 2020 we rewrote our Grant successfully and will receive \$367,531 annually for the next 5 years. We are currently in year three of the Grant Cycle
- 200 students served annually
 - Must have Academic Need **and**
 - Low – Income and 1st Generation
 - Disabled
 - Disabled & Low-Income
 - Low Income
 - First Generation

OBJECTIVES FOR NEW FUNDING CYCLE

- **Persistence Rate:**
 - 55% of all participants served by the SSS project will persist from one academic year to the beginning of the next academic year or graduate and /or transfer from a 2 year to a 4 year institution
 - **Good Academic Standing:**
 - 73% of all enrolled participants served by SSS project will meet the performance level required to stay in good academic standing
 - **2 yr graduation rate:**
 - 33% of new participants served each year will graduate with an associate's degree or certificate within 4-yrs
- AND**
- **2 yr transfer rate:**
 - 13% of new participants served each year will transfer with an associate's degree or certificate within 4 yrs

- Supplemental Grant Aid (students receiving Pell Grant) 2022/2023 will award \$35,000

SSS STAFF

- 6 staff members
 - Project Director- 100% grant funded
 - Data Specialist/Secretary – 100% grant funded
 - Academic Advisor – 100% grant funded
 - Counselor – 50% grant funded/50% covered by College
 - English Specialist – 50% grant funded/50% covered by College
 - Math/Science Specialist – 75% grant funded/25% by College
