Barton County Community College July 9, 2024 Study Session Published Budget

The cover page of the published budget is below. The Board is being presented with two options for the published budget. The RNR rate for FY25 was provided by the County and is 28.634. Our current mill levy is 29.691. The current mill levy was adjusted by the County after the budget was adopted due to a late change in the valuation (was certified at 29.754).

The intent is to remain revenue neutral at the 28.634. This should generate the same tax dollars as requested last year. Because the RNR is based on an "estimated valuation" there is always the chance that the certified valuation could increase or decrease. Because of this, we will notify the County Clerk of "our intention to exceed the RNR" and will have an RNR hearing. We do this in the event that the certified valuation is less than the estimate. Again, the total tax dollars will not change and we would remain revenue neutral.

The County's estimated valuation increased this past year (Approximately \$12,629,945) mainly due to increases real estate and personal property.
